

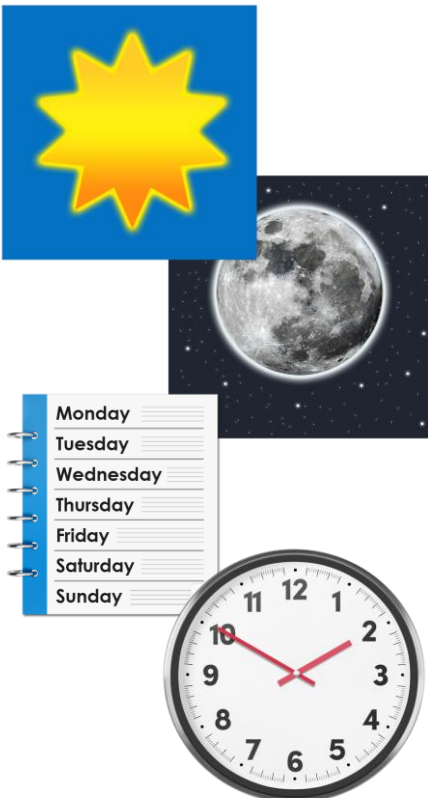
What is the Bury Shared Lives?

Shared Lives is a scheme that means you will be cared for in the carers family home



Your care could be for

- a day session
- a couple of nights
- a week or two
- or all the time



Who can use the Shared Lives

Anyone who is over 18 who

- Has a learning disability
- Has autism or asperger's syndrome
- Has a physical disability
- Has mental health problems
- Is an older person with support needs



You will be matched with a Shared Lives carer

A carer could be

- Single
- With a partner
- In a family
- Has pets
